

Indemnity vs. Medical













## Alabama Claim Frequency

Lost-Time Claims, per \$ Million of On-Leveled Premium




Based on NCCI's Financial data through 12/31/2021, on-leveled, and developed to ultimate, with premium adjusted to common wage level.

Adjusted to Common Wage Level vs. Actual, in \$ Thousands



Adjusted to Common Wage Level vs. Actual, in \$ Thousands



Lost-Time vs. Medical-Only, per 100,000 Workers



PY 2018 vs. PY 2019, in \$ Thousands





PY 2018 vs. PY 2019, in \$ Thousands




#### Alabama Distribution of Claims by Injury Type


#### Alabama Indemnity Loss Distribution by Injury Type
