

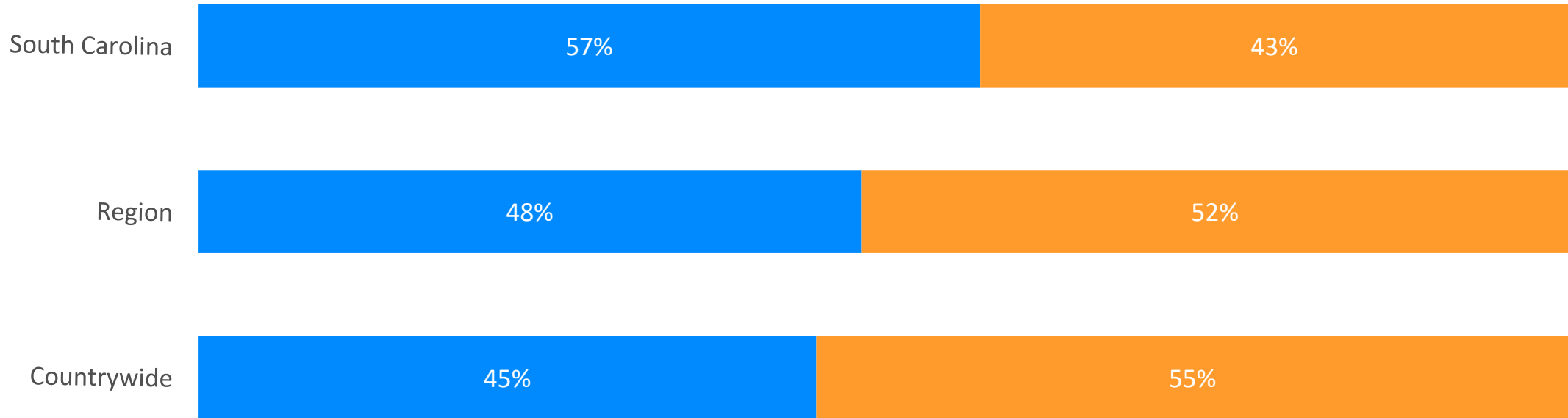

Total Benefit Costs in South Carolina

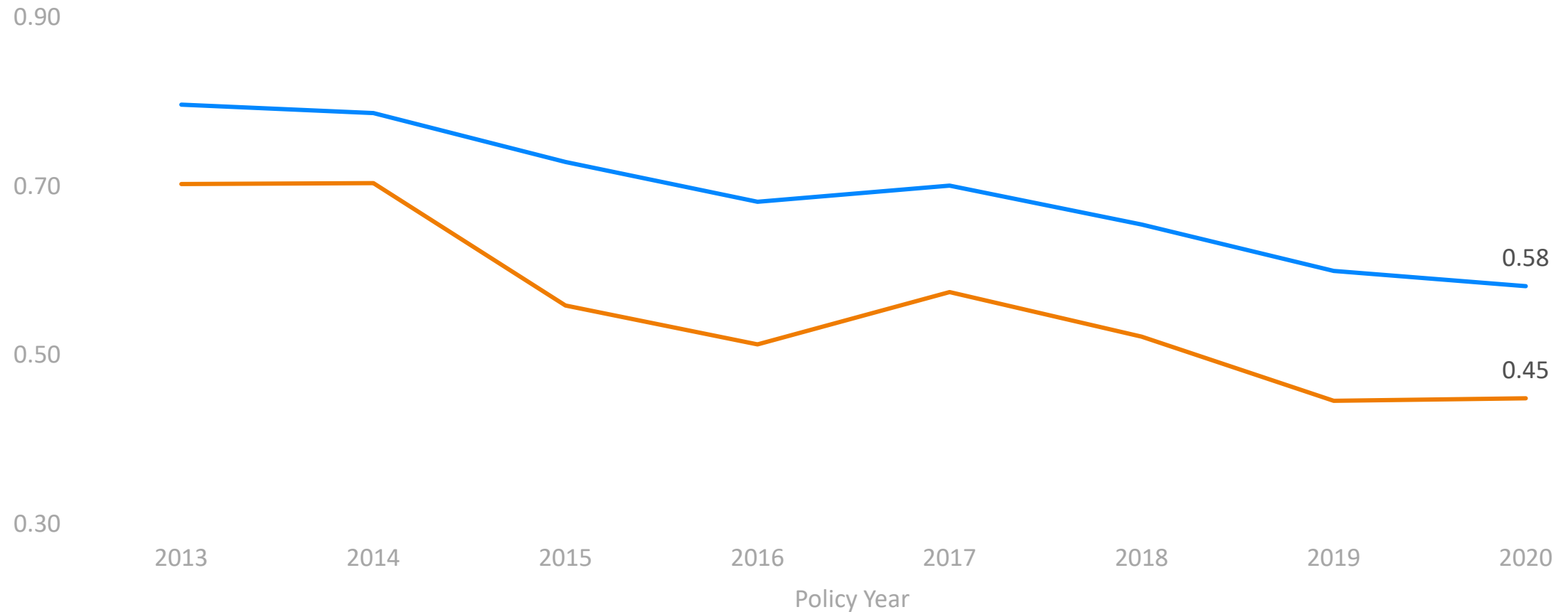
Indemnity vs. Medical

Indemnity vs. Medical

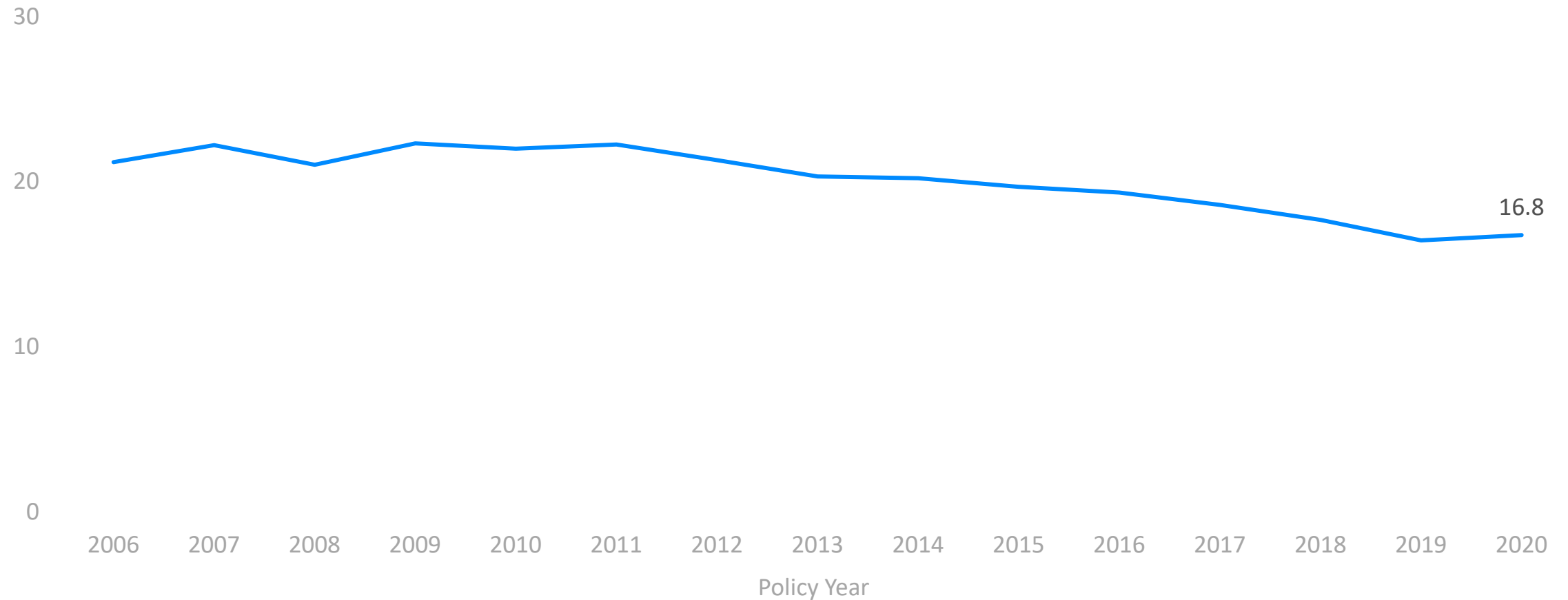

Lost-Time Claims, per \$ Million of On-Leveled Premium

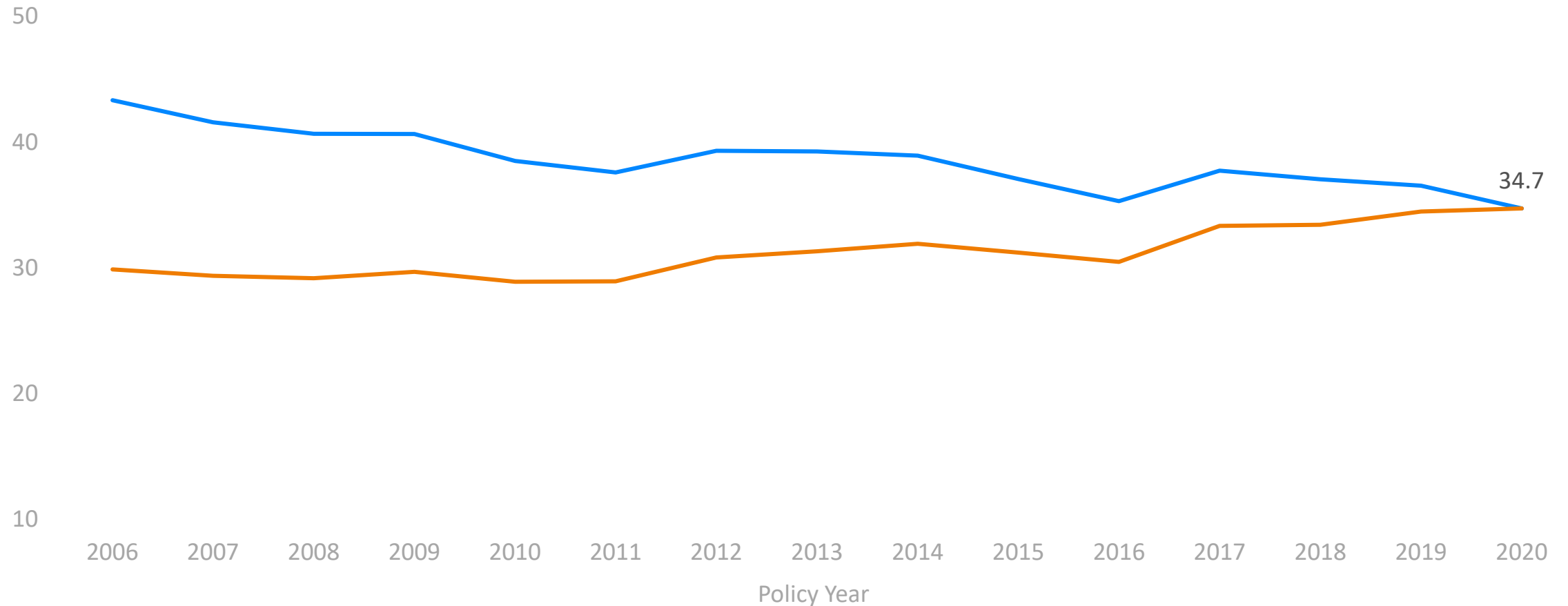

Adjusted to Common Wage Level vs. Actual, in \$ Thousands

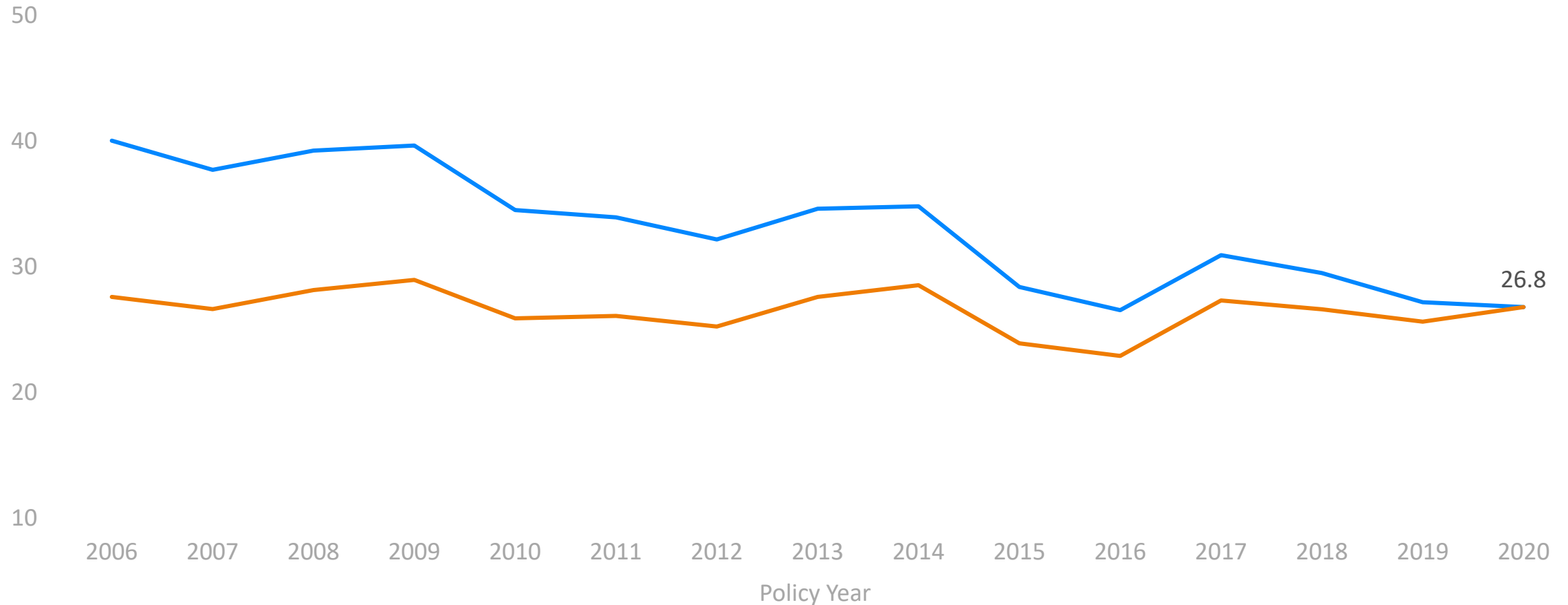

South Carolina Average Medical Claim Severity

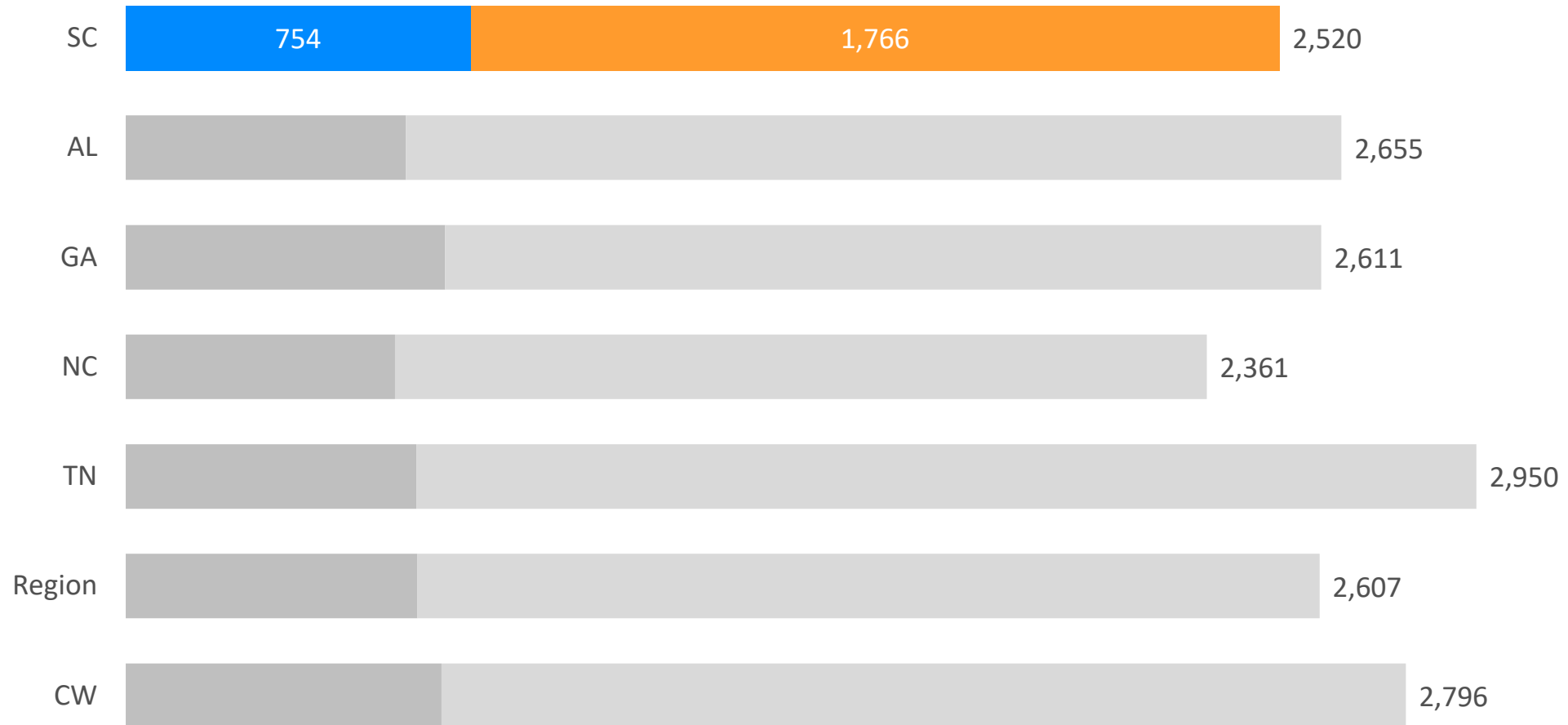

South Carolina Average Claim Frequency

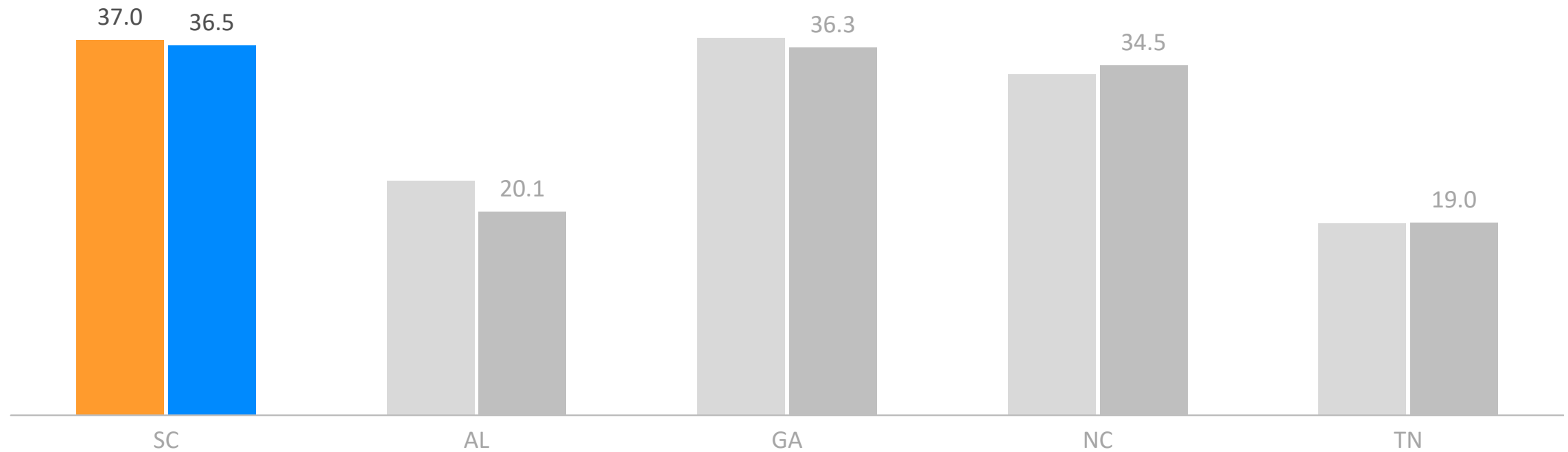
Lost-Time vs. Medical-Only, per 100,000 Workers

Average Indemnity Claim Severity in the Region

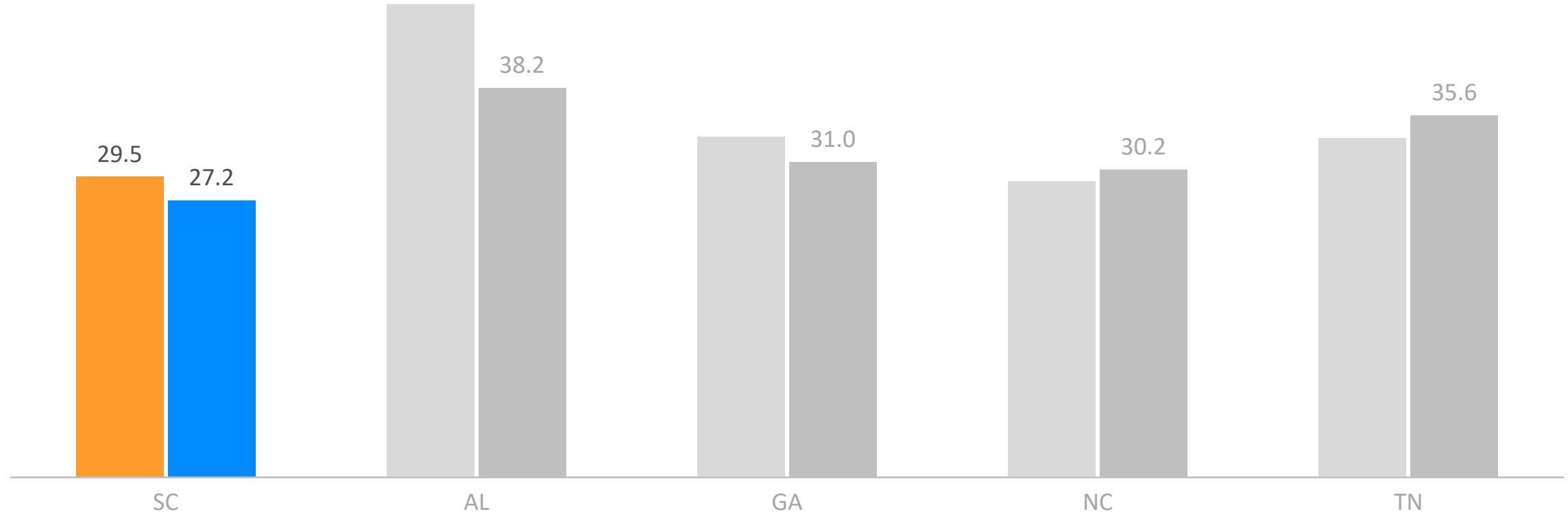
PY 2018 vs. PY 2019, in \$ Thousands

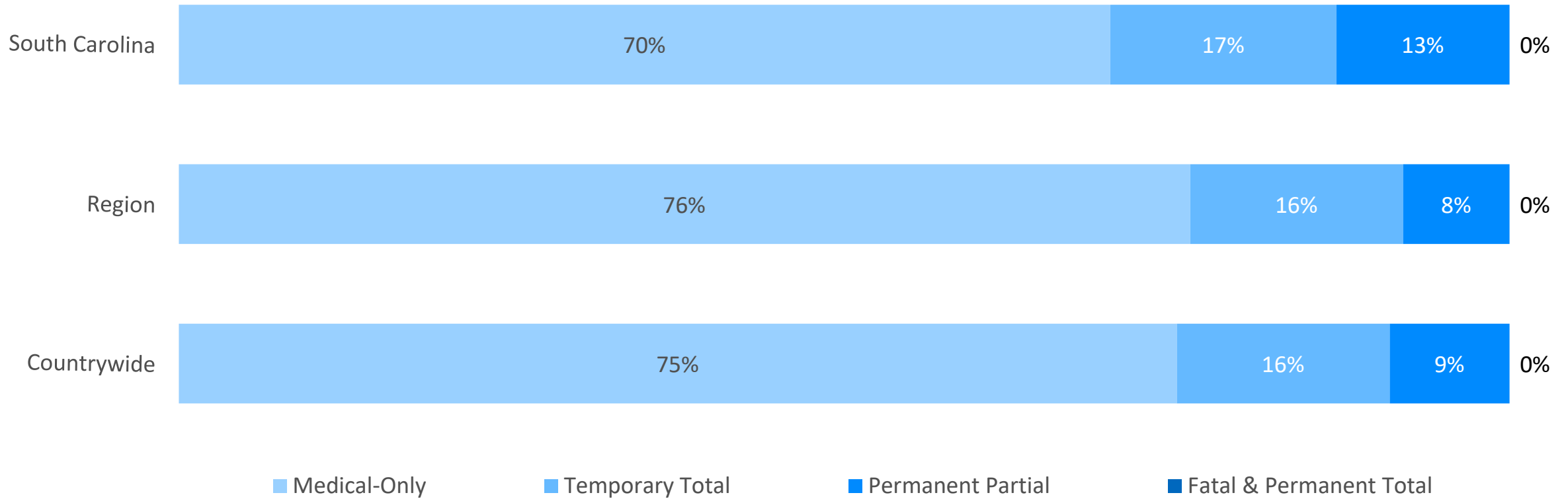
Average Medical Claim Severity in the Region

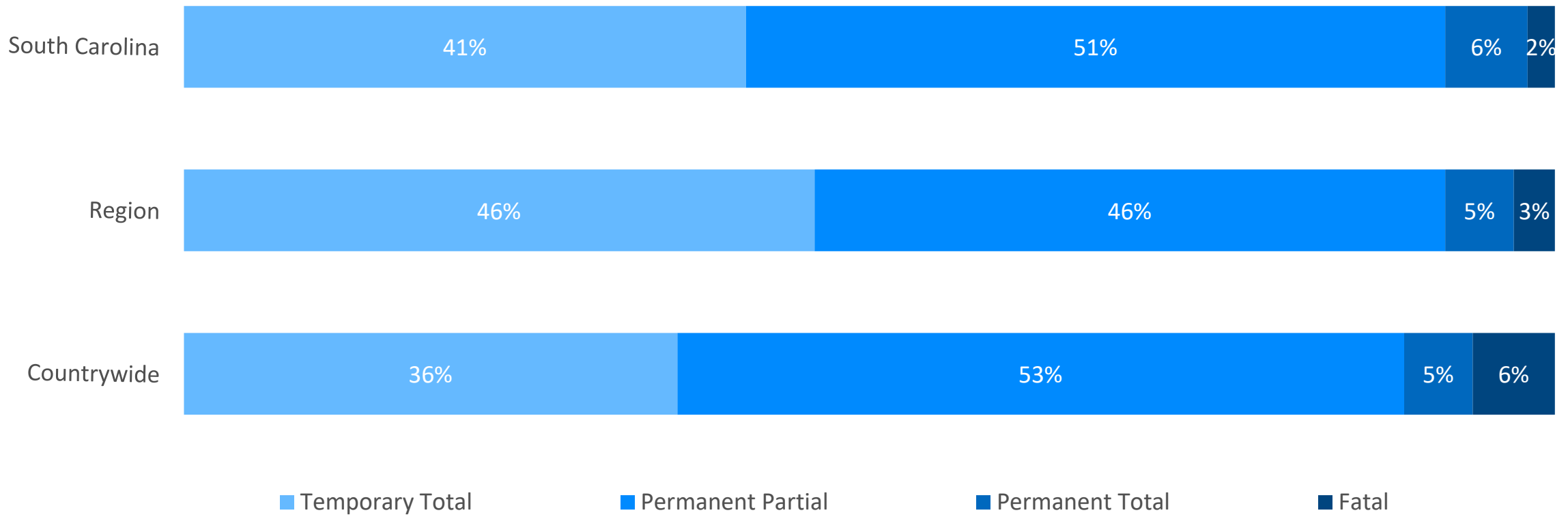
South Carolina Distribution of Claims by Injury Type

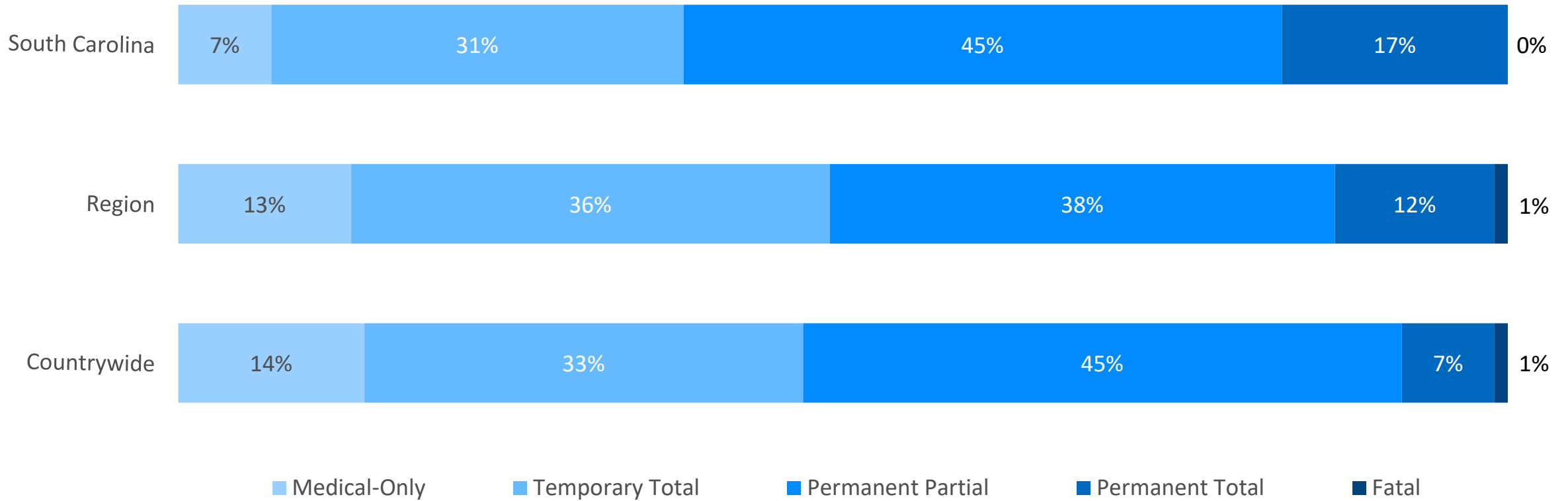
South Carolina Indemnity Loss Distribution by Injury Type
