

Indemnity Data Call—Live Webinars Coming Soon!

While Indemnity Data Call reporting will not begin until mid-2020, we understand the industry efforts required to gear up for future reporting. So, in September 2018, we will be offering a series of Live Webinars to provide future Indemnity Data Call reporters (including service providers such as third party administrators) with additional information on this new data type.
