July 14, 2020—Actuarial Committee Update

The Actuarial Committee met via Web teleconference on Tuesday, July 14, 2020. The major topics covered at this meeting included:

ACT-20-04 COVID-19 Pandemic-Forces Influencing Frequency & Severity NCCI sought insight into claim compensability as part of monitoring the effects of COVID-19 and possible inclusion in a pandemic catastrophe provision that NCCI is currently exploring. Staff discussed alternative sources of data being considered.

ACT-20-05 Texas Methodology Updates

Staff reviewed a plan, and its impact, to update the actuarial methodologies used to produce loss cost and rating values in Texas.

ACT-20-06 The Impact of Fee Schedule Updates on Hospital Outpatient Payments Using a regression model, NCCI investigated the relationship between fee schedule updates and payment for hospital outpatient services. NCCI found that a 10% increase in outpatient maximum allowable reimbursement results in a 7.5% increase in payments.

ACT-20-07 Large Loss Behavior

NCCI presented the results of an update to the periodic review of large loss development patterns by size of loss across a broad array of experience and development periods, adding four calendar years of large loss experience to the latest study (2016).
